

Exploratory art

Young students will learn how to work with a variety of art materials and their properties. Art making is taught within the context of children's literature and examples of masters of fine art. Students will have fun working with paint, clay, collage, and printmaking methods. This is an 8-week course with most projects completed within each week. Grades K-1st.

Early American art

Students will enjoy working with clay, sculpture, drawing, sand, and fiber as we study Native North American art and culture. This is an 8-week course with projects overlapping from week to week. Grades 2nd through 4th.

Super Heroes and Heroines

Students will learn how to draw their own heroes and heroines beginning with schematic figure drawing skills and moving on to portrait drawing techniques. Classical and contemporary heroes and heroines will be discussed along with incorporating individual values towards the development of their own hero. Comic book design, lettering, and illustration will be presented. Students will also learn how to construct their own comic book cover using colored pencil and India inks. This is an 8-week course and requires additional drawing practice. Grades 5th -12th.
